

Call for Board Members

The Environmental Education Commission (EEC) is a non-profit, charitable organization, responsible for running the <u>Echo Pond Environmental Education Centre</u> (previously called the Brother Brennan Centre).

The Centre is located in an off-grid wilderness area near Salmonier Line and is open May-November of each year. The site includes buildings, 6+ kilometres of hiking trails, an environmentally-sensitive boardwalk across a bog, a 'kitchen' garden, and a variety of green energy technologies, including wind turbines, solar panels, and a high-efficiency biofuel furnace.

Our mandate is to provide outdoor environmental education to children and youth, giving them opportunities to connect with and learn about the natural world. We have been offering overnight programming to school groups since the 1980s and in 2015 launched Echo Pond Summer Camp.

We are a vibrant organization whose mission of connecting children and youth to nature is more important than ever at this time. Several exciting initiatives and partnerships are currently underway and we are looking forward to our 2023 season!
